Definitions

(Local Government Act and Code of Conduct)

Pecuniary

An interest that a person has in a matter because of a reasonable likelihood or expectation or appreciable financial gain or loss to the person or another person with whom the person is associated. (*LG Act s442 and s443*).

A Councillor or member of a Council Committee who is present at a meeting and has a pecuniary interest in any matter which is being considered must disclose the nature of that interest to the meeting as soon as practicable.

The Councillor or member of a Council Committee must not take part in the consideration and voting on the matter and be out of sight of the meeting. (LG Act s451)

Non-Pecuniary

An interest that is private or personal that the Councillor or member of a Council Committee has that does not amount to a pecuniary interest as defined in the LG Act.

If you have declared a non-pecuniary interest you have a number of options for managing the conflict. The option you choose will depend on an assessment of the circumstances of the matter, the nature and significance of your interest. You must deal with a non-pecuniary interest in one of the following ways.

Non Pecuniary – Significant Interest

(For example; family, a close friendship, membership of an association, sporting club, corporation, society or trade union).

- Have no involvement by absenting yourself from and not taking part in any consideration or voting on the issue as if the provisions in the LG Act s451(2) apply.
- A future alternative is to remove the source of the conflict (for example, relinquishing or divesting the personal interest that creates the conflict or reallocating the conflicting duties to another officer).

Non Pecuniary – Less than Significant Interest

• It may be appropriate that no action is taken. However, you must provide an explanation of why you consider that the conflict does not require further action.

Important Information

This information is being collected for the purpose of making a special disclosure of pecuniary interests under sections 451 (4) and (5) of the *Local Government Act 1993.* You must not make a special disclosure that you know or ought reasonably to know is false or misleading in a material particular. Complaints made about contraventions of these requirements may be referred by the Director-General to the Local Government Pecuniary Interest and Disciplinary Tribunal.

This form must be completed by you before the commencement of the council or council committee meeting in respect of which the special disclosure is being made. The completed form must be tabled at the meeting. Everyone is entitled to inspect it. The special disclosure must be recorded in the minutes of the meeting.

i. Section **443** (1) of the *Local Government Act 1993* provides that you may have a pecuniary interest in a matter because of the pecuniary interest of your spouse or your de facto partner or your relative^{iv} or because your business partner or employer has a pecuniary interest. You may also have a pecuniary interest in a matter because you, your nominee, your business partner or your employer is a member of a company or other body that has a pecuniary interest in the matter.

ii. Section **442** of the *Local Government Act* 1993 provides that a *pecuniary interest* is an interest that a person has in a matter because of a reasonable likelihood or expectation of appreciable financial gain or loss to the person. A person does not have a pecuniary interest in a matter if the interest is so remote or insignificant that it could not reasonably be regarded as likely to influence any decision the person might make in relation to the matter or if the interest is of a kind specified in section **448** of that Act (for example, an interest as an elector or as a ratepayer or person liable to pay a charge).

^{iii. A pecuniary interest may arise by way of a change of permissible use of land adjoining, adjacent to or in proximity to land in which a councillor or a person, company or body referred to in section 443 (1) (b) or (c) of the} *Local Government Act 1993* has a proprietary interest—see section 448 (g) (ii) of the *Local Government Act 1993*.
iv. *Relative* is defined by the *Local Government Act 1993* as meaning your, your spouse's or your de facto partner's parent, grandparent, brother, sister, uncle, aunt, nephew, niece, lineal descendant or adopted child and the spouse or de facto partner of any of those persons.

Subject: INVITATION FROM HANDA CITY COUNCIL TO ATTEND THE QUINQUENNIAL DASHI FESTIVAL IN OCTOBER 2012

Discussion

The Handa Sister-City Sub-Committee were previously advised (30 August 2012 Meeting and subsequently at the Ordinary Meeting of Council on 27 June 2012) of the invitation extended by Handa City Council for three (3) people to attend the Dashi Festival held in Handa, Japan in October 2012.

A letter of invitation dated 4 September 2012 was forwarded to the Principal of Westport High School. A reply, dated 15 October 2012, was received from the relieving Principal of Westport High School advising that due to staffing changes proposed for 2013, Westport High School would be unable to host the students from Handa Higashi Senior High School.

A letter of invitation dated 22 October 2012 was forwarded to Mr Jim O'Brien of the Catholic Dioceses extending an invitation to one of the senior college campuses in Port Macquarie to host the Handa Higashi Study Group Tour in 2013. A reply dated 6 December 2012 was received from Mr Jim O'Brien advising that MacKillop Senior College has accepted Council's offer to host the 2013 Handa Higashi Senior High School Study Tour.

In previous years the Study Tour Group has visited Port Macquarie in the last week of July, departing early August staying a period of five (5) days in our region. An email has been sent to Handa Higashi Senior High School on 18 March 2013 requesting confirmation of the date that the 2013 Study Tour group will arrive in and depart from Port Macquarie. Once these dates have been confirmed, contact with MacKillop Senior College Campus Principal - Mr Tim McCosker, will be made to advise the Campus of the confirmed tour dates.
