Subject: MAYORAL MINUTE - EXTENSION OF WAIVING OF FEES FOR

FERRY SERVICES

RECOMMENDATION

That Council:

- Note the resolution of Council dated 31 March 2021 regarding the waiving of fees associated with the use of the ferry service until 30 April 2021.
- 2. Extend the waiving the fees and charges associated with the use of Council's ferry services until the Hibbard ferry is reintroduced back into service.
- 3. Credit any pre-purchased passes for ferry use over this period in the new pass purchase cycle.
- 4. Continue to record ferry usage data during this period for the purposes of future consideration of extension to ferry hours.

Discussion

At Council's Extraordinary Council meeting held 31 March 2021, Council resolved:

That Council:

- 1. Waive the fees and charges associated with the use of Council's ferry services until 30 April 2021, effective from 28 March 2021.
- Credit any pre-purchased passes for ferry use over this period in the new pass purchase cycle.
- 3. Continue to record ferry usage data during this period for the purposes of future consideration of extension to ferry hours.

The expiry date of 30 April 2021 for the waiving of fees was determined based on the expectation that the Hibbard ferry would have been returned to service by this date following the required maintenance. It is now apparent that as a result of damage caused by the floods to the contractor's facilities undertaking the maintenance, the Hibbard ferry will not be returned to service by 30 April 2021 as previously expected. It is now recommended to Council that the waiving of fees and charges associated with the use of Council's ferry services be extended until he Hibbard ferry is reintroduced back into service.
