Comments by Mayor

Well known local resident, Maureen Cooke, recently passed away aged 95 years.

Maureen was born in Port Macquarie (nee Denning) and grew up on the family property on Kennedy Drive.

After completing schooling, Maureen trained as a tailor and then moved to Sydney. She quickly secured employment with leading tailoring and female attire companies before establishing her own fashion labels - Maureen's Models and Marty's Models. Maureen's husband, Eric, joined her in the business and her designs featured in all the major Department stores and in 1970, won the ACT Gown of the Year.

In 1971, at the height of her business success, she returned to Port Macquarie to care for her ill father.

Maureen was active in local community matters over many years, including:

- Establishing Endeavour House:
- Establishing the Port Macquarie Art Society and annual Art Exhibition;
- Hamilton Green advocacy by Maureen and her late husband Eric to secure as public space;
- Volunteer at the Dementia Memory and Community Centre:
- Pastoral carer.

Maureen was still active in the community up until about three years ago when she had to slow down due to being in her 90's.

We remember Maureen for her unwavering ethic of service, and lifetime commitment to our local area, and we pass on our condolences to Maureen's family, friends and colleagues.
